Home-grown TV is right up our street

IT WAS the year the critics began to run out of abuse, and even the Government complained about the flood of US imports on TV.

Meanwhile the rest of us just got on with watching our usual British favourites - home-grown comedy and drama

Coronation Street, already the most popular programme in the history of British television, was once again the nation's favourite in 1993, attracting a peak of **20.7** million viewers for one episode.

BBC situation comedy celebrated a vintage year, clinching second, third and fourth place, with One Foot In The Algarve, Only Fools and Horses and Birds of a Feather.

ITV drama remained dominant, with the makers of such hits as Prime Suspect III, Heartbeat and London's Burning apparently untroubled by the din of the City predators carving up their companies.

The only Hollywood films to make it into the 1993 Top 30 were Ghost, Pretty Woman and Ghostbusters II. American formats like the BBC's 999 and ITV's Gladiators failed to register.

Only one brand-new series figured in the chart - the disastrous adaptation of A Year In Provence, starring John Thaw. Yet of the 14.5 million viewers who tried it, only four million stayed to the end.

Many of last year's winners survive only on the drip-feed of Christmas specials (Only Fools, One Foot In The Grave); or have come to the end of their runs (Morse, Darling Buds of May); or cannibalise the medium itself (Aunties Bloomers, It'll Be Alright on the Night).

But Michael Barrymore almost single-handedly revived that faded old dowager, the Royal Variety Performance.
